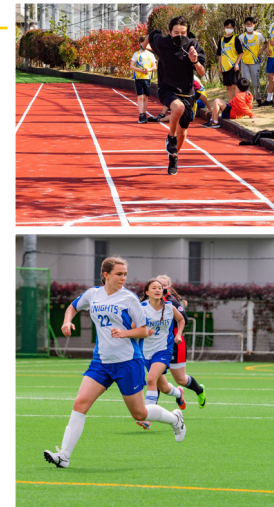
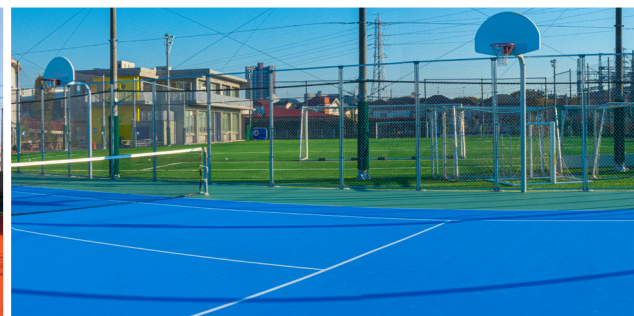
Equipping students to serve Japan and the world for Christ.

PHASE 2 of **IMPACT 75** included the redevelopment of the playing field, tennis courts, and playground equipment and was fully completed in June 2022. It has been a transformative project for the campus, providing even more benefits than envisaged. Students use the field and courts for sports, play, and spaces to chat and hang out together, all without getting dusty or scratched! The playground structures provide physical challenges and stimulate creative and imaginative play, and our whole community can enjoy the new relaxed social spaces.



PHASE 3 the final for **IMPACT 75**, is now our focus, and more detail will follow in coming months. It will include some renovation of existing spaces and provision of new areas to accommodate growth. We want our students to have new spaces that will allow for inspired learning and design thinking, and that continues to meet our mission of equipping students for the future awaiting them. We also aim for CAJ education to continue to be affordable for families who want their children to have a biblically-based English language education.
